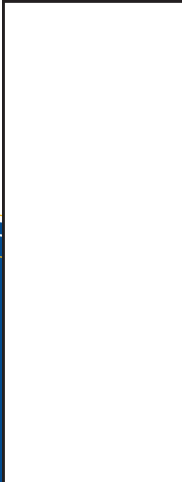

Training Programs

- Ingrid Garrison, DVM, MPH, DAVPM will be the featured speaker on the transmission of diseases that are communicable between animals and humans such as rabies. Presentation will also include basic necessary Personal Protection Equipment (PPE) and protocols for disease prevention.
- Regionally recognized husbandry methods will be taught by one of the agents of the Johnson County Extension Office. Species to be covered include bovine, equine, and small ruminants.
- Officer safety is a continuing priority in the volatile environments that ACO's encounter and require continued training.
- Chemical Capture (Optional)
This class includes classroom and hands-on training in the use of tranquilizer equipment, including use of appropriate immobilization drugs. *Students will receive a certificate of completion for this course.*
